3. A new pattern of examination was introduced in the month of January to discourage rote learning & to lay emphasis on conceptual clarity, same will be followed in Annual examinations.
4. Total weightage of marks for each subject is 50. The exam for each subject will be in two parts - **Subjective and Objective**.
5. The weightage of Subjective paper is 30 marks and the weightage of Objective paper is 20 marks.

A. Paper Timings for Objective paper

- i. Reading and attendance : 8.15 a.m. to 8.30 a.m.
- ii. Writing time : 8.30 a.m. to 9.10 a.m.
- iii. Break : 9.10 a.m. to 9.30 a.m

B. For Subjective paper

- i. Reading and Attendance : 9.30 a.m. to 9.45 a.m.
- ii. Paper timing : 9.45 a.m. to 11.00 a.m.


It is mandatory for students to appear in the exams. In case of any problem, they may immediately contact the class teacher.
